HumanFirst used DiMe's crowdsourced <u>Library of Digital</u> <u>Endpoints</u>, which includes industry-sponsored studies of new medical products or new applications of existing medical products, to confirm a viewpoint on digital clinical measures: that too many measures of similar concepts are being reported in different ways.
