

The <u>DiMe Research Committee</u> is a member-led initiative that stands up working groups to pursue research questions proposed directly by the DiMe member community.



- A clear process for reporting adherence to digital solutions in publications did not exist, limiting the value of published data.
- We wanted to connect back to EVIDENCE to showcase that a similar model might also be applied to reporting digital studies of adherence.

The EVIDENCE checklist provides a clear process for authors to follow throughout study design, data collection, analysis, and reporting.

The Resources

- We reviewed the <u>EVIDENCE checklist</u> to understand what the authors had recommended in terms of reporting adherence to BioMeTs and ensure that our recommendations were consistent with EVIDENCE.
- Alternatively, if we noted substantial deviations between EVIDENCE and our recommendations, we could provide a rationale.
- > We adopted this same model as we developed recommendations for reporting adherence, which strengthened our resulting manuscript.

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The Impact

 The checklist provided a model for developing recommendations for reporting adherence.

✓ We were able to ensure our guidance was consistent across other related research efforts.
